Protect your colleagues, build UNISON's strength and make sure you and your colleagues are kept safe by becoming a UNISON safety rep.

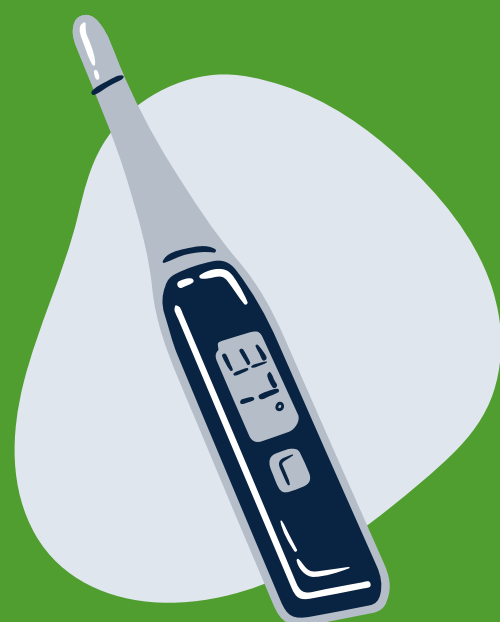
Your employer must:

-  Identify hazards that may harm their staff.
-  Identify those staff at risk.
-  Estimate the chance of harm occurring.
-  Identify ways to avoid or reduce the risk.
-  Record the assessment and keep it under review and up to date.

We need to strengthen the union at your school to keep staff safe and informed!

A safety rep tackles important issues:

- Social distancing rules
- Any new working arrangements
- PPE
- Reasonable adjustments
